NOTES:

1. Per the December 1995 sanction meeting, if an entrant to a speed event does not have an assigned number but wants to use a number other than the one assigned by the committee of the event, the entrant must pay \$10.00 for the use of this number. This charge of \$10.00 will be made at each event the number is used. **The \$10 shall be payable to the Midwest Region.**
2. Per the December 1998 sanction meeting, a deadline extension may be granted if an entrant desires to apply for a "permanent" number assignment equal to his/her NCCC Convention registration number for the current year. The application must be postmarked no later than June 15 and must follow all the steps as outlined in the Speed Event Number Procedure. In addition, the applicant must provide the RCD with a copy of his/her Convention registration confirmation at the time of the application.
